

Using DVDit 6

NB Set up a new folder for the DVD files on the external hard drive before commencing. After task 1, the tasks detailed below will differ where alternative DVD burning packages are used.

1. While still in Avid, create a duplicate sequence, activate all the tracks required, put a In point at the beginning and an Out point at the end of the desired material, then go to Clip => Render In/Out. Mix Down both the Video and Audio tracks. Export file to desktop (from AVID) as QuickTime reference (or as a quicktime movie to create a file for upload to the web).
2. Open DVDit 6
3. Click on File – Save As – Name file
4. Click on Palette – Media tab
5. Click on little folder icon (green arrow above)
6. Import Quicktime Reference files from desktop or folder
7. Drag imported video file from palette onto title icon in project window
8. When sound is imported a chime will sound
9. Click save project (ctrl+s)
10. Check at bottom of screen that DVD-5 (4.7GB) is selected
11. Place DVD in Drive
12. Click on Burn from menu
13. Select burn DVD
